

There are many things which can affect your body's natural lubrication, and at some point in time, all of us will likely be faced with a situation where we're not as wet as we'd like to be.

I've used most water based, glycerin based, and silicone based lubes for a variety of sexual activities. If

you use sex toys like vibrators, clitoral vibes, dildos or anal toys you've also likely experimented with several brands available at your local pharmacy – but each of these products has drawbacks and limitations, and they don't feel quite so natural.
